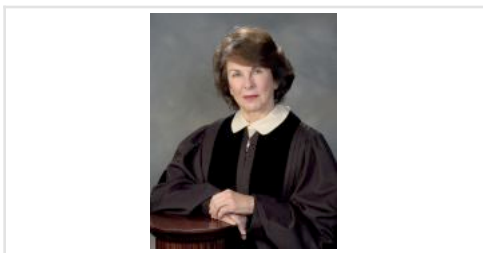

Hunstein began practicing law in Georgia in 1976, and served as a Judge of the Superior Court of DeKalb County prior to her appointment to the Georgia Supreme Court in 1992. She is an Adjunct Professor at Emory University School of Law and has been recognized for her service to the court and her community throughout her career. She has served on the Supreme Court Indigent Defense Commission, Advisory Board of the Georgia Campaign for Adolescent Pregnancy Prevention, State Bar of Georgia Multi-disciplinary Practice Committee, Georgia Commission on Child Support, National Association of Women Judges, Council of Superior Court Judges of Georgia, Georgia Commission on Gender Bias in the Judicial System, and the Advisory Board for the Justice Center of Atlanta.
